

BY-LAW NO. 43
(October 1, 2010)

A By-law of the College of Medical Radiation Technologists of Ontario (the "College") relating to professional liability insurance.

BE IT ENACTED as a By-law of the College as follows:

1. A member must hold, or otherwise be covered by, professional liability insurance that provides that person with coverage for the practice of the profession of medical radiation technology.
2. The professional liability insurance referred to in section 1 must have, for each insured individual, a minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
3. The professional liability insurance referred to in section 1 must not be subject to a deductible which is greater than \$1,000.00.
4. The professional liability insurance referred to in section 1 must be provided by an insurer that is licensed under the Financial Services Commission of Ontario.
5. Within 30 days of any request by the Registrar, and at the time or times determined by the Registrar, a member shall provide confirmation of insurance coverage, satisfactory to the Registrar, to demonstrate that the member's professional liability insurance coverage complies with the requirements set out in this By-law.
6. This By-law comes into force on the day subsection 24(13) of the *Regulated Health Professions Statute Law Amendment Act, 2009* comes into force.
